

Unit 2 exercise keys.

For some exercises, answers are provided only for certain items, as indicated.

Exercise 1.

Máo: Lìsān, nǐ hǎo.

Lǐ: Ei, Dàwéi, nǐ hǎo. Jīntiān (nǐ juéde) zěnmeyàng?

Máo: Hěn lèi, nǐ ne?

Lǐ: Wǒ yě yǒu diǎnr lèi – hái méi chīfàn ne. Nǐ ne, è bu è?

Máo: Bú è le, wǒ yǐjing chī le.

Lǐ: Hǎochī ma?

Mao: Mǎmǎhūhū. ... etc.

Exercise 2. Chinese equivalents

wǒ de qiánbāo

sān ge* lǎoshī

tāmen de yīfu

tā de yānjìng

liǎng ge rén

qīyuè sì hào de bào

tā de dōngxi

sì ge xuéshēng

Zhāng lǎoshī de hùzhào

zuótīān de bào

liǎng kuài qián

tā de zìxíngchē

* People might use the polite measure “wèi” here to show respect towards the teachers, but the teachers are not being addressed directly, so “ge” is fine.

Exercise 3. Chinese for Q and A

Q

Jīntiān shì bu shi èrshíjiǔ hào?

(Jīntiān <shi> èrshíjiǔ hào ma?)

Zhè shi nǐ de sān ma?

(Zhè shì bu shi nǐ de sān?)

A

Bù, jīntiān <shi> sānshí hào.

Bù, nà shi Zhāng lǎoshī de.

Shéi shi dì-yī <gè>?

Hǎoxiàng Wáng Jié shi dì-yī <gè>,
Liú Guózhèng shi dì-èr <gè>.

Note: *Wáng Jié hǎoxiàng shi dì-yī <gè>*, with *hǎoxiàng* focused not on *Wáng Jié*, but on *Wáng Jié's position in the sequence*: “Wang Jie, it seems, is #1 (not #2...)”

Nǐmen dōu shi xuéshēng ma?

Shì, wǒmen dōu shi Wèi lǎoshī de
xuéshēng.

Nà shì bushi nǐ de zìxíngchē?

Bù shì wǒ de, shi Léi Fēng de.

(zìxíngchē = dānchē = jiǎotàchē)

Exercise 4 (odd numbers only)

Nín guàixìng?

1. Wǒ xìng Liáng, jiào Liáng Xìnghàn.
3. Wǒ xìng Wáng, jiào Wáng Yǔyàn.
5. Wǒ xìng Lǐ, jiào Lǐ Bó.
7. Wǒ xìng Lǐ, jiào Lǐ Yǒngyàn.
9. Wǒ xìng Zhōu, jiào Zhōu Yǔ.
11. Wǒ xìng Ōuyáng, jiào Ōuyáng Pèishān.

Paraphrase (odd only):

1. Wǒ shi lǎoshī.
3. Tā xìng Sòng, jiào Sòng Měilíng.
5. Tā shi shéi? / Tā shi wǒ de lǎoshī.

Note: Alternative to *shéi*: *shuí*.

7. Tā xìng Chén, jiào Chén Bó.
9. Zhè shi Wèi shīfu.

Exercise 5. Into Chinese:

Dialogue A:

甲	乙
Bàozhi zài nǎr?	Zuótīān de ma?
Bù, jīntīān de.	Duìbuqǐ, bù zài wǒ zhèr.
Yǐqián zài nǐ nàr.	Kěshì xiànzài bù zài wǒ zhèr le.

Alternatives: zài nǎr ~ zài nǎlǐ (nǎlǐ is probably more common); yǐqián ~ běnlái; kěshì ~ dànsì.

Vocabulary for B: sùshè ‘dormitory’

Dialogue C:

甲	乙
Shéi de shūbāo?	Bú shi wǒ de, wǒ méiyou shūbāo.
Shi Lǐ Dān de ma?	Bù, Lǐ Dān de zài wǒ zhèr.
Shì bu shi Liú Míng de?	Bù, tā hái méi qǐlái.
Shi Sūn Hào de ba.	Shì ma?

Note: shūbāo, or in the north, often shūbāor.

Exercise 6 (odd only):

Paraphrase:

1. Hǎo, nà shi sān ge rén le.
3. Hǎo, jiù zhèi yàng ba, wǒ zǒu le.
5. Wǒmen dōu chī le, zài fēijī shang chī le.

7. Huānyíng nǐmen lái [Běijīng].
9. Jiù zhèi yàng ba, míngtiān jiàn.
11. Nǐ ni, nǐ kě bu kě?

Comment that:

1. Wó hái méi chīfàn ne.
3. Tā hái méi xǐzǎo.
5. Wǒ hái méi kàn jīntiān de bào.
7. Wǒ bù jǐnzhāng le.
9. Tāmen yǐjing shuìjiào le.
