

## *Unit 3 exercise keys.*

### **Exercise 1. Geography**

Tiānjīn zài Zhōngguó běibiānr, lí Běijīng dàgài yǒu yìbǎi gōnglǐ. Shènyáng zài dōngběi, lí Běijīng yě bú tài yuǎn. Shènyáng zài Liáoníng. Chéngdū zài Sīchuān zhōnggbù. Chóngqìng zài Chéngdū de nánbiānr, kěshì bú zài Sīchuān de nánbù; shi ge zhíxiáshì. Kūnmíng zài Yúnnán, Yúnnán bú shi Yuènán. Yúnnán shi Zhōngguó de yí bùfen, kěshì Yuènán bú shi Zhōngguó de yí bùfen, shi zài Zhōngguó de xīnán.

### **Exercise 2. Chinese equivalents**

‘Nǐ bàba shi Déguórén, duì ma?

‘Shì de, kěshì wǒ māma shi Měiguórén, suǒyǐ wǒ shi Měiguó, Déguó de liǎng ge guójí. (~ Wǒ shi Měiguó guójí, yě shi Déguó guójí.)

Nánjīng shì bu shi lí Shànghǎi bù yuǎn?

Duì a, bú tài yuǎn, dàgài <yǒu> liǎng bāi gōnglǐ.

Tāmen bú shi Zhōngguó rén ma?

Duì, tāmen dōu bú shi Zhōngguó rén. Tāmen liǎng ge shi Hánguórén, liǎng ge shi Tàiguórén.

Nà bú shi nǐ de sǎn ma?

Bú shi wǒ de. Shì lǎoshī de, wǒ xiǎng.

Tiānjīn lí Běijīng jìn bu jìn?

Hěn jìn. Lí Běijīng dàgài <yǒu> yìbǎi bāshí gōnglǐ.

11. Xīguā yí kuài bā máo yì jīn – wǒ yào yí gè.

### **Exercise 8. English to Chinese (odd only)**

1. Wǒ de diànhuà hàomǎ: liù-líng-sān qī-qī-qī bā-sì-líng-yāo.
3. Jīntiān yígòng yǒu duōshao xuéshēng?
5. Shíyuè sānshí hào yǒu kǎoshì.
7. Yīnwèi yǒu nàme duō kǎoshì suǒyǐ wǒ yǒu yìdiǎnr jǐnzhāng.

### **Exercise 9. Say it in Chinese (odd only)**

1. Wǒ zhèi ge xuéqī yígòng xiū sì mén kè, dōu hěn nán.  
Sentence could open with zhèi ge xuéqī, wǒ ...; instead of xiū: yǒu or shàng; many say zhè ge rather than zhèi ge.
3. Wǒ xīngqī'èr-sì kè hěn duō, kěshì xīngqīsān zhǐ yǒu yì táng (~ jié, even gè).
5. Shùxué de lǎoshī bú tài yán, dànshì kǎoshì hěn nán. (~ fēicháng nán)
7. Wǒ zuótiān hěn jǐnzhāng, kěshì jīntiān hǎo le.

### **Exercise 10. Correcting errors, improving sentences**

1. Confusion of le (change) and ne (continuity, particularly with hái). Wǒmen hái méi chī ne.
3. Xìng cannot usually be cited alone: Zhōu lǎoshī, xiǎo Zhōu, Zhōu Yǔ....
5. Wǒ yě shows the influence of English ‘me neither’. In Chinese, adverbs tend to be cited with a verb: Wǒ yě méi chī.
7. Influenced by English word order ‘what exams do you have’. Chinese does not front question words: Míngtiān nǐ yǒu shénme kǎoshì?
